20% of the school day

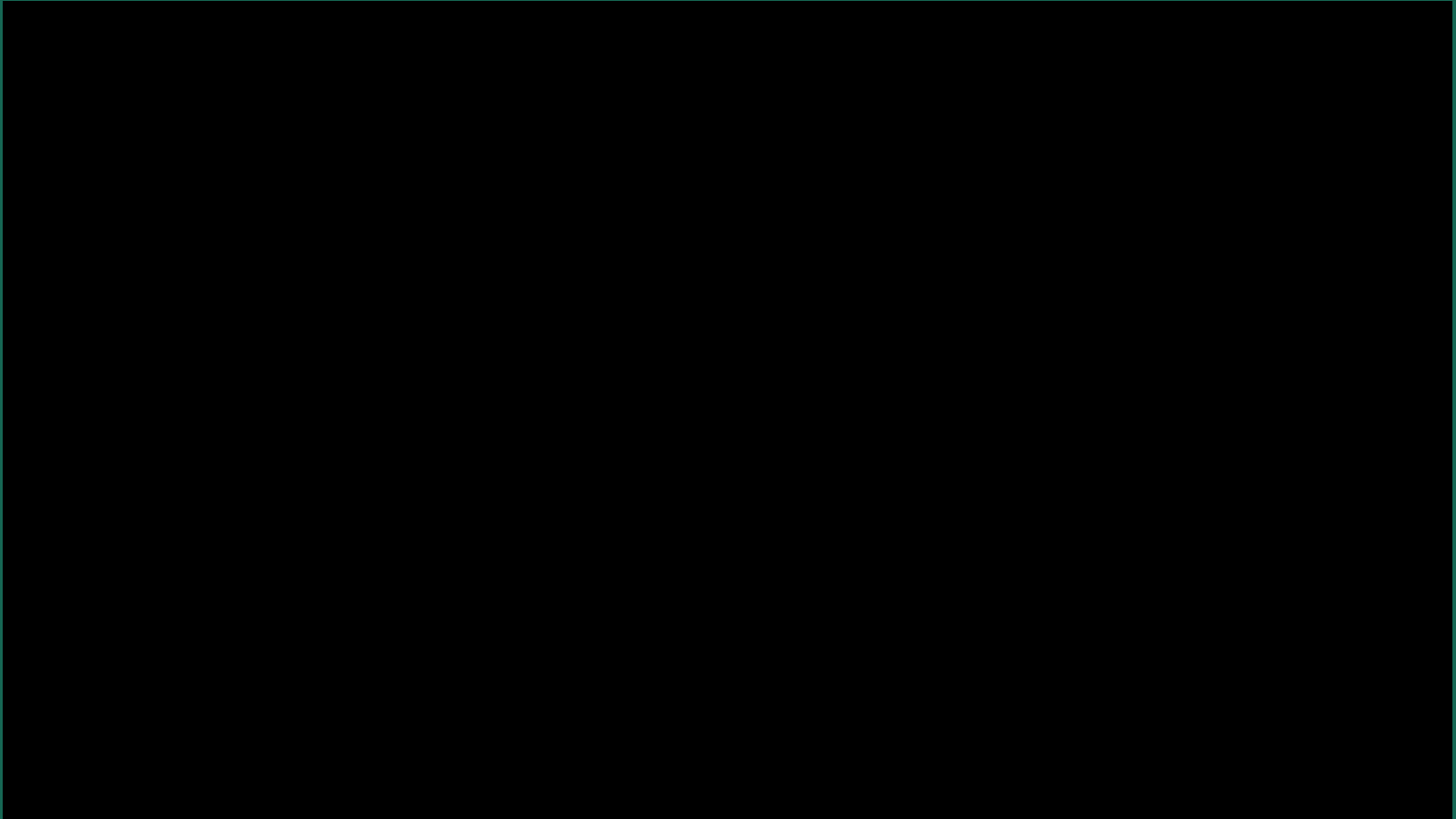
