



HOME SCHOOL AGREEMENT



As a school, we recognise that educating children is a process that involves partnership between parents/carers, staff at the school, pupils and the wider school community. As a partnership, our parents will understand the importance of a positive working relationship to equip children with the necessary skills for their time at Courthouse. For these reasons we continue to welcome and encourage parents/carers to participate full in the life of our school.

The purpose of this agreement is to provide a reminder to all parents, carers, pupils and staff of our school about the conduct expected of them. This is so our children can continue to flourish, progress and achieve in an atmosphere that fully embodies the Courthouse values.

AS A PARENT/CARER AT COURTHOUSE, I WILL:

- Support the school and its decisions.
- Ensure that my child attends school each day on time.
- Ensure that my child wears full school uniform.
- Trust that the school will handle conflicts that involve my child in an appropriate manner.
- Support my child in reading with them everyday.
- Support my child with home learning and encourage a love of learning.
- Respect all staff members.
- Ensure that my child respects all staff members, pupils and the Courthouse community.
- Raise any issues or concerns privately with a member of staff.
- Contribute positively to whole school life and support school events.
- Be aware that the school operates a rigorous safeguarding and child protection policy which exists to protect the children and school community.
- Ensure my child is prepared for school: has had a good sleep, eaten and has the required equipment.
- Monitor my child's online activity and ensure they use media that is appropriate for their age.
- Engage with school communication by reading all emails and providing consent where needed.

AS A PUPIL AT COURTHOUSE, I WILL:

- Attend school on time, each day.
- Wear full school uniform.
- Be respectful to all staff, pupils and the wider Courthouse community.
- Model the 'Courthouse Values' each and every day.
- Treat everyone equally.
- Resolve conflict peacefully.
- Be aware that negative behaviour is detrimental to my own and others' learning.
- Take pride in all of my learning.
- Take pride and enjoyment in my home learning and home reading.
- Help keep the school premises clean and tidy by respecting equipment and property.
- Act responsibly online and be aware of the importance of online safety.
- Contribute positively to school life.
- Act responsibly during playtimes and adhere to our play charter.

AS A MEMBER OF STAFF AT COURTHOUSE, I WILL:

- Respect all members of the school community.
- Expect exemplary behaviour as standard.
- Ensure close adherence to all school policies, in particular the Safeguarding and Child Protection Policy.
- Provide a balanced curriculum.
- To inform all parents/carers of their child's progress at school.
- Inform parents/carers of any behaviour concerns.
- Adopt and promote the Courthouse values in all aspects.
- Be supportive and solutions focused.
- Contribute positively to whole school life.
